Every January KRCB conducts a Community Appearance Index Judging Tour. The purpose of the judging tour is to monitor and track: litter, graffiti, illegal signs, abandoned/junk vehicles and outside storage trends throughout the City of Riverside. Results from the CAI are used as research for prevention programs within our schools, public awareness, and KRCB Beautification projects throughout the year.

There will be a minimum of four (4) judges, a designated driver, and someone to assist with navigating sites. Judges can be from: KRCB Staff, KRCB Advisory Board Members, city employees, and the community (optional). Judges will score up to five (5) sub areas in all of the seven (7) Riverside council wards. The sub areas are half mile to full mile stretches that consist of the following locations: residential, mall/shopping center, school, park and business district.

| 3 | Moderate Graffiti - long swatches, or combined amounts of graffiti of approximately 12 feet long |
| 4 | Predominate Graffiti - graffiti is seen continuously; the site may require equipment and a crew to remove |

4	Predominate Outside Storage – Items that would fill one car garage approximately 10’ by 20’
